- Food Stop** – further extension to shop roof (by 4' 6") to sit on posts on boundary wall
- Myrtle Cottage** – additional uPVC window (1000mm x 800mm) on north elevation
- La Closette** – shed (7' x 5' x 6' high) to house invalid carriage
- St. Peter's Church** – new public notice box (same height, twice the width of existing)
- Carrick-a-Rede** – amendment to approved application with changes to windows and slates

- Field View, La Perronerie** – wooden garden shed (8' x 12' x 6' high) FULL APPROVAL
