Rosedene – removal of small window on the east gable and relocated to rear in place of back door

La Valette Camp Site – provision of three cocoons (camping huts) [3m x 3m x 2.5m high] **APPROVED**

Le Vallon d'Or – three new dormers on the south side for extra light but fitted with obscure glass **APPROVED**

La Petit Piece – demolition and replacement of existing extension; replacement roof tiles; new dormer **APPROVED**

La Valette de Bas – extension at the rear of the barn [2.44m x 15.24m x 2.44 high] **APPROVED**

The Old Station, The Avenue – replacement of two windows, extension at west end under existing roof **APPROVED**

La Mer – replacement windows and new cladding - outstanding condition met - **FULL APPROVAL**
