Decisions made on the applications posted in the Boxes during September/October

La Friponnerie – To erect two 2-story dwellings on land at La Friponnerie. – **DEFERRED**
(still pending information requested of applicant)

Valette de Haut – To erect solar panel array (approx. 120m x 60m or 7200m²) – **DEFERRED**
(following advice from Chief Pleas, defer until after Electricity public consultation)

Clos du Manoir – To erect a shed behind Telephone Exchange (2.62m x 3.71m x 2.34m high) - **APPROVED**

Seigneurie Gardens – To erect greenhouse (4.5m x 7.6m 3.8m high) - **APPROVED**

Other decisions made at the October meeting

St Magloir – to extend previous granted permission for solar panels - **ACCEPTED**

“Grand Clos” Clos de l’Ecluse – permission in principle for a dwelling in the ‘southeast corner’ of the field – **PERMISSION IN PRINCIPLE** (subject to a full application)
