BY-ELECTION 14 September 2011 – Pollsters and Scrutineers Volunteers

The Returning Officer requires assistance from members of the public to help run the by-election in September.

Volunteers are required to man the Polling Station (Toplis Room at Island Hall) between the hours of 10am and 6pm with a team of three persons for each 2-hour period. The Constable under the direction of the Returning Officer is responsible for the supervision of the Polling Station.

At the closing of the Polling Station at 6pm further volunteers are required to conduct the Count, the Count being held in the Assembly Room. A team of 4 persons are required for the Count and a further 4 persons on standby to conduct any recount that may be necessary, either that night or the following day.

The Returning Officer has already received offers of assistance, which he has accepted. However, further volunteers are still required and any person interested should apply to the Returning Officer (Seneschal), no later than 3pm on Wednesday 7th September; telephone: 832993 (answer phone available), in person between 1pm and 3pm at the Seneschal's office or by email to: seneschal@gov.sark.gg.
