

# **PRESS RELEASE**

## **OUTCOME OF SARK PERCEPTION SURVEY**

At a large gathering of residents, held in the Sark Island Hall last Monday evening, Ms Cathryn Hannah, Head of the Crown Dependencies Team at the Ministry of Justice, presented the outcomes and analysis of the recent questionnaires, sent to all households in Sark.

In total, 225 completed questionnaires were forwarded to the MoJ offices in London, where they were recorded using specialist software and the responses compiled into a report which is now available from the Sark Government's web-site, [www.gov.sark.gg](http://www.gov.sark.gg)

The main areas where residents registered concerns included, Land Use and Planning, Environmental and Conservation Issues, Cost of Health Care, Government Administration and Economic Development.

After a number of questions relating to the outputs of the questionnaire were discussed, Temporary Chief Secretary, Colin Kniveton, advised the audience that the evidence contained in the analysis along with future engagement with the electorate would help to guide future Government policies and would be contained within the "*Vision for Sark*" document that is currently being prepared.
