BY-ELECTION 4 December 2013 – Pollster and Scrutineer Volunteers

The Returning Officer requires assistance from members of the public to help run the By-Election in December.

Volunteers are required to man the Polling Station (Toplis Room at the Hall) between the hours of 10am and 6pm with a team of three persons for each 2-hour period during the day. The Constable, under the direction of the Returning Officer, is responsible for the supervision of the Polling Station and the Count.

At the closing of the Polling Station at 6pm further volunteers (Scrutineers) are required to conduct the Count, the Count being held in the Main Room of the Hall; the Count will start shortly after the Polling Station closes. A team of 4 persons are required for the Count and a further 4 persons on standby to conduct any recount that may be necessary, either that night or the following day.

The Returning Officer has already received some offers of assistance, which he has accepted. However, further volunteers are still required and any person interested should apply to the Returning Officer (President of Chief Pleas), no later than 3pm on Wednesday 27th November; telephone: 833028 (answer phone available), in person between 1pm and 3pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Fridays at the President of Chief Pleas' office, by email to: president.chief.pleas@gov.sark.gg, or in writing.

A briefing for the appointed Pollsters, Scrutineers and the Constables will take place at 5.30pm on Monday 2nd December in the Board Room of the Hall.
