Guidelines for Sark leisure boat owners - not Commercial vessels – wishing to use the facilities at Guernsey Harbours:

Drop offs/pick ups

The Cambridge steps, the pontoon at the end of the Albert Pier and the steps at the end of the Crown Pier can be used by Sark leisure boat owners for quick drop offs and pick-ups only. Boats should not be left unattended at these points, they are for the safe and quick transfer of people and not for any other use.

Short stay – 2 to 3 hours (not overnight)

Designed for small boats: RIBS, Dorys, etc. with a shallow draft

The west side of the walk-ashore pontoons in the pool can be used for boats with a shallow draft, for those wishing to go ashore for a few hours. This area can be shallow, especially on a Spring tide, so extra care should be taken as the Marina Staff cannot be responsible for any vessel that goes aground. This pontoon is for short stay only and not for overnight or long periods of time. If anyone is unsure where the walk-ashore pontoons are, please ask the Marina Staff on your arrival in the Harbour.

From time-to-time, especially during July and August, capacity may be at its maximum in all the visitor areas of St. Peter Port harbours. During these times, the walk-ashore facility may be temporarily unavailable to local (including Sark, Herm and Jethou) boat owners. The Marina Staff will advise that they must give priority to visiting yachtsmen during exceptionally busy times.

Short stay – up to 6 hours (not overnight)

Designed for small and large boats

The local layby pontoon at the entrance to the fairway can be used to moor boats for those wishing to go ashore for a few hours. This pontoon is for short stay only and not for overnight or long periods of time. If anyone is unsure where the local layby pontoon is, please ask the Marina Staff on your arrival in the Harbour.

Long stay - overnight

For those wishing to stay overnight in St. Peter Port, we would be pleased to welcome them into the Victoria Marina as a paying visitor, provided there is enough capacity. As a paying visitor, all guests of St. Peter Port harbours can use the shower facilities on the Albert and Crown Piers.
