

PUBLIC INFORMATION NOTICE

On Thursday the 11th September the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight (BBMF) will be taking part in air shows in Guernsey and Jersey. It has been arranged with the Guernsey organisers and Air Traffic Control that at the end of their display in Guernsey the flight (a Lancaster Bomber, a Spitfire and Hurricane fighter) will overfly Sark on their way to display in Jersey. There is a possibility that a Canadian Lancaster Bomber will be with the flight.

The BBMF start their display at 11.00 AM and end at approximately 11.18 AM. They should therefore be overhead Sark soon after 11.20 AM.
