



A statement on the use of 'Drones' (small unmanned aircraft) over Sark

The government have been approached regarding the use of drones (unmanned aircraft) over Sark. We consulted Mr Gus Paterson, the Director of Civil Aviation for the Channel Islands, who confirmed that the *Sark restricted area R095* prohibits all flights without express permission, and we include in this all use of small unmanned aircraft (commonly known as 'drones').

Against this background and in order to preserve our R095 zone the flying of unmanned aircraft above, over or around Sark is prohibited. If you are in any doubt about the use of these unmanned aircraft, then do not use them.
