Derek Lickorish said, “At the ‘backbone’ of any successful economy you have a reliable, affordable and sustainable supply of electricity. Through a subsea cable from Guernsey this could now be a reality for Sark with low carbon energy from the European mainland. There are still some challenges ahead but given a unity of purpose from the community and support from other key stakeholders it is within Sark’s grasp, with the added bonus of a reliable high-speed broadband connection as well”.
