**APPOINTMENT OF TAX ASSESSORS**

The term of office of the current Tax Assessor, Mr Trevor Kendall, will expire on 31 December 2013.

Mr Simon de Carteret was appointed Assistant Tax Assessor by Chief Pleas at its Christmas meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2013 (Min. Ref. 12.5).

The Committee nominates Mr de Carteret to the appointment of Sark Tax Assessor to take office on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014 and to serve for a period not exceeding five years.

Mr Kendall is prepared to serve a short term as Assistant Tax Assessor in order that his experience as Tax Assessor since 2004 will be available to Mr de Carteret during the initial period of his term of office.

The Committee nominates Mr Kendall to the appointment of Assistant Tax Assessor to take office on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014 and to serve for a period not exceeding one year.

The Committee asks Chief Pleas to approve the following propositions:

**Proposition 1 -**

**That Chief Pleas appoints Mr Simon de Carteret as Sark Tax Assessor to take office on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014 and to serve for a period not exceeding five years.**

**Proposition 2 –**

**That Chief Pleas appoints Mr Trevor Kendall as Sark Assistant Tax Assessor to take office on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014 and to serve for a period not exceeding one year.**
