Clos de Cerf – Permission in Principle for a Crazy Golf Course, with support facilities – **PERMISSION IN PRINCIPLE**
[also known as Grand Clos de Chers]

La Breque – To erect a lean-to for an 'electric buggy' (1.7m x 4.3m) – **CONDITIONALLY APPROVED**
