## Island Safeguarding Officer (ISO) Vacancy

We are seeking to appoint a positive, discrete but determined Safeguarding Officer for Sark.

Main responsibilities of this role:

- To be the named Designated Safeguarding Officer and to safeguard and protect the community of Sark
- To receive safeguarding referrals and co-ordinate the procedures which address and prioritise the needs of those affected
- To liaise with the Safeguarding officials both on and off the Island as appropriate
- To deliver safeguarding training, update and implement policies and procedures and share learning with staff and volunteers in positions of responsibility
- To ensure personal professional understanding is up to date and in line with current best practice and legislation

The role does not receive a salary, but an honorarium will be paid as well as all expenses incurred. The role is line managed by Beverley Martin (Director of Education) and supervised by a fellow Safeguarding professional.

Candidates should have experience or qualifications in Safeguarding. Those without qualifications must be willing to train and be subject to a full DBS check.
