CORONAVIRUS UPDATE:

RESIDENTS RETURNING FROM GROUP A COUNTRIES:

Individuals should self-isolate, irrespective of symptoms if they have returned from the following areas in the last 14 days:

- Mainland China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau)
- Iran
- South Korea
- Specific lockdown areas designated by the government of Italy

RESIDENTS RETURNING FROM GROUP B COUNTRIES:

- Thailand, Japan, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Singapore, Malaysia or Macau.
- Northern Italy (defined by a line above, and not including, Pisa, Florence and Rimini),
- Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Indonesia, France, Egypt, Tenerife - returning since 17 February 2020.

If you experience symptoms (fever, cough or shortness of breath, no matter how mild) and have returned from the above countries in the last 14 days, then stay indoors and contact Sark Medical Centre on 832045.

ISLANDERS are now required by law to notify the authorities if they think they may have contracted the coronavirus Covid-19, and if anyone tests positive for the illness they will be compulsorily quarantined.

Residents who are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, however mild, must not under any circumstances visit the Medical Centre unannounced.
